

How to make a pocket heart

- 1. Choose your two felt colours and use your template to cut out a heart shape.
- 2. Anchor your thread by sewing three stitches on top of each other, in the top centre of your heart.



- 4. Stuff your heart by putting small pieces in the hole and poking them in to fill all of the heart.
- 5. Stitch the hole shut and finish with three stitches on top of each other to secure the thread.



- ~Use high quality, 100% wool felt for a durable little heart that can withstand lots of loving. You can buy it online or call Lyrebird store on 03 62311433 to order.
- ~I use two strands of embroidery cotton to sew the hearts.
- ~Chenille needles work very well.
- ~Hobby Fill or similar synthetic stuffing is good—I stuff them to be quite firm as that makes a good tactile heart that will cope with lots of squeezing!









How to make a pocket heart
